That's a wrap for our Winter focused January! The children enjoyed exploring snow, ice, winter animals and more. Our sensory bin was full of penguins, polar bears and lots of snow and ice. We investigated winter animals and what their habitats are like during the winter months.

Heading into February the class will shift to focusing on Love and Art. As we get ready for the virtue of Love, the class will share their thoughts on what Love means to them. We will learn about ways Love can be shared at school, home and in our communities. We invite families to share their Love all month long by sending in "Letters of Love" to their child. Letters can be anything from little notes to special cards. There will be a mailbox outside of the preschool classroom for mail to be delivered. We ask that each child receives at least two pieces of mail throughout the month.

We will celebrate Love with a Valentines party on February 14th. During our party we will have a valentine card exchange. There are 24 students in the classroom if your child would like to bring in cards to pass out. If there are treats attached to your Valentine's, we ask that they are store bought as well as peanut/tree nut free. Valentines can be left in the cubby area until our party or can be dropped off with a preschool staff member prior to the 14th. Your child is also welcome to dress up in their fanciest attire as we will have a dance after our card exchange.

February will also bring a focus on art. The preschool children will learn about a variety of artists and their styles. We will then adapt it to the preschool developmental level to recreate some famous works of art. The children will get to work with paint, clay, photographs and more.
