Happy November, can you believe it is already almost the end of the year!? Toddlers have been soaking up as much of the fall weather as we can before the freezing cold months hit. During the month of October we learned a lot about fall weather, traditions, and colors changing. The toddlers enjoyed using a sponge to paint pretty fall leaves onto a tree. We got to crack open two different kinds of pumpkins to observe and learn the differences between the two. Once we were done playing with the pumpkin guts the toddlers loved painting them and setting them outside in the front of the building. This past month we have been working hard on counting up to 5 and singing our ABCs, ask your child to count or sing with you!



November is all about Weather. Each week will be a different weather theme. Week one we will be talking about rain. We will make our own rain shakers, paint a rain drop, try to make rain with water, and much more. Week 2 we will be learning about storms, what they look like, the different types of storms, what they might sound like, ect. Week 3 we will be learning about snow. We will be experimenting with making different types of snow and different textured snow. Week 4 we will be learning about temperature, cold and hot. We will do various flashcard activities during group time as well as playing in warm, room temp, and cold water. We are going to continue to work on our ABCs, counting to 5, and colors throughout the unit.



Important Notes:

The weather is getting colder and we are starting to expect snow any day now. Please start bringing in weather appropriate clothes for outside. Licensing guidelines states we are required to take the kids outside everyday for at least 30 minutes, weather permitting. If you are ever wondering what weather would be considered dangerous for outside play we have a weather guide hung on the inside of the door. When bringing in outdoor clothes and boots, please **label** everything, this includes both gloves and hats too. Some kids have the same outdoor gear and as the outdoor gear comes in it can be hard to remember who's is who's. I will be holding conferences starting **November 6th**. If any of those dates/times do not work for you please let me know. The center will be closed **November 25th and November 26th**.
