Books, Books and more BOOKS! In the Toddler classroom we enjoyed exploring different types of books and storytelling. We will practice different safety drills throughout the month and explore why we do these drills. We encourage you to talk about safety in your home too! The class will look at different community helpers and learn how they help us around our community.

Our dramatic play will be turned into a pet hospital with different doctor tools. By providing different toys in our room allows the class to explore different skills and play out what they see in the world around them.

We will have special days sprinkled throughout the month of May!

May 9th we will have a bike day . Please bring a riding toy and a helmet to school. Make sure the helmet and riding toy are labeled and parked in front of the school.

May 14th weather permitted our class is going to have a bubble party on our playground. This activity may get a little wet, please make sure your child has a pair of extra clothes in their cubby.

May 29th we will have a much request water day (weather permitted). Please Bring a swimsuit, towel, plastic bag for wet clothes, and closed toed water shoes.
